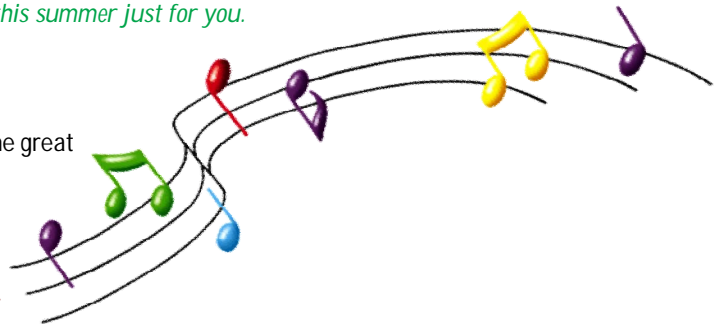

THE ROAD TO WIMBLEDON

The Wimbledon Foundation, the charitable and development arm of the All England Club and The Championships Wimbledon announced the launch of The Road to Wimbledon in India in 2014, a new initiative aimed at boosting the development of junior tennis in the country. India is the first country outside of UK where Wimbledon has run an event of this magnitude. This tie-up provided a great opportunity and exposure to our upcoming junior players.

The club and the foundation returned in 2015 with an extended programme, with qualifying events in Kolkata, Chandigarh, Delhi and Mumbai followed by a Masters event in Delhi. Paul Hutchins in a press conference in Delhi thanked the support received from the AITA towards the junior development initiative. The press conference was jointly addressed by Mr. Tim Henmann & Mr. Goran Ivanovic – Wimbledon Champion.

The week of the Masters (6–11 April 2015) was held from the in DLTA Complex. All the top 16 boys and girls who had qualified for the masters through their grind of four weeks of qualifying were given full hospitality at the DLTA for the entire week. The Masters was structured with Round Robin matches where the top two of each group played in knockout draws to decide the two top spots.

Alongside the matches, players had intensive coaching clinic sessions with Dan Bloxham, Tim Henmann and Goran Ivanovic. DLTA also organised the regional coaches workshop attended by over 60 coaches and the players had lectures and on court sessions with Paul Hutchins, Dan Bloxham, Tim Henman and Goran Ivanovic.

ROAD TO FRENCH OPEN

In 2015 French Tennis Federation (FTF), the organizer of the French Open (Roland Garros) signed a MOU to intensify the development process of tennis and boost junior talent in India. The MOU was signed during the Opening Ceremony of "Rendez-Vous a Roland - Garros, in Partnership with Longines", a junior tournament which offers a wildcard for the 2015 French Open Junior Tournament in Paris. This is a unique opportunity for Indian Junior players to experience the atmosphere of a Grand Slam and the unique culture of a Parisian red carpet.

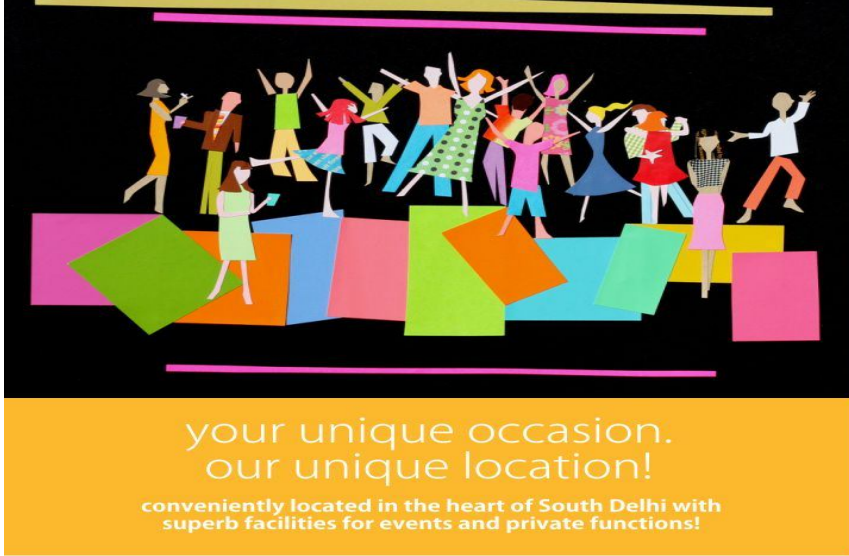
